State Forester Prohibition of Fire Causing Activities and Fireworks on State Trust Lands


Pursuant to the provisions of ARS § 37-623, the State Forester has declared a prohibition on open fires, fireworks, and smoking on all State Trust Lands within Yuma, Maricopa, Pinal and La Paz Counties, and the southern portions of Yavapai and Gila Counties.

The following restrictions on fire causing activities will be in effect from Wednesday, May 26th, 2010 at 12:00 PM, through July 31st, 2010, or until further notice, on all State Trust Lands within Yuma, Maricopa, Pinal, and La Paz Counties, and the southern portions of Gila and Yavapai Counties:

1. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, or charcoal burning device, except as specifically permitted by the State Forester on a case-by-case basis is prohibited. Petroleum fueled stoves, lanterns, or heating devices are exempt from these restrictions.
2. Using fireworks, as defined in ARS § 36-1601 is prohibited.
3. Smoking, except within a closed vehicle, building, developed campground or while stopped in an area at least 10 feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable materials is prohibited.
4. Welding or operating acetylene or other torch with open flame is prohibited.

These restrictions also apply to all lease and permit holders.

Any state, federal, or local fire or law enforcement officer, or member of an organized firefighting force is exempt from these prohibitions while in the performance of their official firefighting duties.

Yuma County: All State Trust Lands


Maricopa County: All State Trust Lands

Pinal County: All State Trust Lands

La Paz County: All State Trust Lands

Gila County: All State Trust Lands south of State Highway 60

Yavapai County: All State Trust Lands in the lower elevations with an approximate northern boundary following State Highway 93 south to County Highway 97, County Highway 97 northeast to County Highway 96, County Highway 96 east to Kirkland Hillside Road, Kirkland Hillside Road southeast to State Highway 89, State Highway 89 to the Prescott National Forest western boundary, then progressing to the south, east, and then north following the Prescott National Forest boundary to State Highway 69 near Cordes Junction, then due east to the Tonto National Forest western boundary, then easterly along the Tonto National Forest western boundary to the Maricopa County line.
