**A prospective candidate for state, district, county, municipal or township office who has had a felony conviction expunged in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. §§ 16-93-301 to 303 or similar expunction statute in another state may certify that he or she has never been convicted of a felony, provided the candidate presents a certificate of expunction from the court that convicted the prospective candidate. See Ark. Code Ann. § 7-6-102(d)

7-7-305. Printing of ballots - Form.

- (c) (1) (A) A person who files for an elective office in this state may use not more than three (3) given names, one (1) of which may be a nickname or any other word used to identify the person to the voters, and may add as a prefix to his or her name the title or an abbreviation of an elective public office the person currently holds.
- (B) A person may use as the prefix the title of a nonpartisan judicial office in an election for a nonpartisan judicial office only if:
 - (i) The person is currently serving in a nonpartisan judicial office to which the person has been elected in the last election for the office; or
 - (ii) The person:
 - (a) Is a candidate for the office of circuit judge or district judge;
 - (b) Is currently serving in the office of circuit judge or district judge as an appointee; and
 - (c) Has been serving in that position for at least twelve (12) months.
- (C) A nickname shall not include a professional or honorary title.
- (2) The names and titles as proposed to be used by each candidate on the political practice pledge or, if the political practice pledge is not filed by the filing deadline, then the names and titles that appear on the party certificate shall be reviewed no later than one (1) business day after the filing deadline by the Secretary of State for state and district offices and by the county board of election commissioners for county, township, school, and municipal offices.
- (3)(A) The name of every candidate shall be printed on the ballot in the form as certified by either the Secretary of State or the county board.
- (B) However, the county board of election commissioners may substitute an abbreviated title if the ballot lacks space for the title requested by a candidate.
- (C) The county board of election commissioners shall immediately notify a candidate whose requested title is abbreviated by the county board of election commissioners.
- (4) A candidate shall not be permitted to change the form in which his or her name will be printed on the ballot after the deadline for filing the political practices pledge.

Dear Senator Paul:

Michigan will conduct a Presidential Primary on Tuesday, March 8, 2016. In preparation for the Presidential Primary, I am required to issue a list of "individuals generally advocated by the national news media to be potential presidential candidates" for both the Republican and Democratic Parties. MCL 168.614a. The chairpersons of Michigan's Republican and Democratic Parties are similarly required to provide "a list of individuals whom they consider to be potential presidential candidates" for their respective parties. *Id.* All of the lists have now been filed. I write to inform you that your name was placed on one or more of these lists (see www.michigan.gov/elections).

The placement of your name on the above-referenced list(s) automatically qualifies you for Michigan's March 8, 2016 Presidential Primary ballot; no further action on your part is required. The following options, however, are available:

- If you do not wish to appear on Michigan's Presidential Primary ballot, you may withdraw by filing a sworn statement, executed by you and witnessed by a notary public, expressing your desire to have your name removed from the ballot. If you wish to avail yourself of this option, you must, "file an affidavit with the secretary of state specifically stating that '(candidate's name) is not a presidential candidate', and the secretary of state shall not have that presidential candidate's name printed on a presidential primary ballot." MCL 168.615a. The affidavit must be received in the office of the Michigan Department of State's Bureau of Elections no later than 4:00 p.m. (E.S.T.) on Friday, December 11, 2015.
- If you wish to express a preference for a political party which differs from the party designation assigned to you on the above-referenced list or wish to declare that you have "no political party preference," you may effect such a change by filing a sworn statement, executed by you and witnessed by a notary public, which states your interest in altering your party designation. *Id.* The affidavit must be received in the office of the Michigan Department of State's Bureau of Elections no later than 4:00 p.m. (E.S.T.) on Friday, December 11, 2015. (The Republican Party and the Democratic Party are the only political parties that are qualified to participate in Michigan's Presidential Primary. Consequently, if you express a preference for a party other than the Republican Party or the Democratic Party

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or declare that you have "no political party preference", your name will not be printed on Michigan's Presidential Primary ballot.)

- If you wish to participate in Michigan's Presidential Primary but wish to have your name appear on the ballot in a form other than the form shown on the above-referenced list ("**Rand Paul**"), you may modify the form of your name by submitting a written request to this effect. If you wish to request a modification, please notify the Michigan Department of State's Bureau of Elections in writing no later than 4:00 p.m. (E.S.T.) on Friday, December 11, 2015.


