The Secretary of State's Office has completed its initial review in accordance with A.R.S. § 19.121.01(A) and issues the following findings:

- The committee filed 22,166 petition sheets with the Secretary of State's Office.
 - 33 petition sheets containing 337 signatures were rejected because a complete title and text of the initiative measure were not attached to the petition sheets. A.R.S. §§ 19-121(A)(3); 19-121.01(A)(1)(a).
 - 22,133 petition sheets were eligible for verification.
- The Secretary of State's Office rejected 1,711 eligible petition sheets for the following reasons:
 - 0 petition sheets were rejected because they contained a missing or incorrect serial number. A.R.S. §§ 19-121(A)(2); 19-121.01(A)(1)(c).
 - 32 petition sheets were rejected because the circulator affidavit was incomplete, unsigned, or had been modified. A.R.S. §§ 19-112(D) & (F); 19-121.01(A)(1)(d).
 - 16 petition sheets were rejected because the circulator affidavit was not notarized, the notary's signature was missing, the date of notarization was missing, the notary's commission had expired on the date of notarization, or the notary's seal was not affixed. A.R.S. § 19-121.01(A)(1)(e).
 - 9 petition sheets were rejected because the circulator affidavit was notarized before the first signature was obtained on the face of the petition sheet. A.R.S. § 19-121.01(A)(1)(f).
 - 1,473 petition sheets were rejected because they were circulated by circulators who were not properly registered with the Secretary of State's office for I-08-2016 before the petition sheet in question was circulated. A.R.S. §§ 19-118(A); 19-121.01(A)(1)(h).
 - 181 petition sheet was rejected because the petition sheet did not state whether the circulator was paid or a volunteer. A.R.S. §§ 19-102(C)-(E).
- Following petition sheet elimination pursuant to A.R.S. § 19-121.01(A)(1), 20,422 petition sheets remained eligible for signature review. Among eligible petition sheets:
 - 242,861 signature lines were eligible for review pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 19-121.01(A)(2)-(3).
 - 63,427 blank or crossed-out signature lines were not eligible for review.

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- The Secretary of State's Office rejected 3,970 petition signatures because the signature was gathered outside the county of the majority, the signature, address or date was missing from the petition sheet, the signature was obtained before the statement of organization was filed, the signature was obtained before the initiative serial number was issued, the signature was obtained after the notarization date, an excessive number of signatures were gathered on a petition sheet, the signature was withdrawn, or the signer's information was printed by the circulator. A.R.S. §§ 19-121.01(A)(2)-(3).
 - 238,937 petition signatures remained eligible for random sampling and county recorder review. A.R.S. § 19-121.01(A)(4) & (6).
 - The number of eligible petition signatures exceeded the constitutional minimum 150,642 signatures. A.R.S. § 19-121.01(B); Ariz. Const. Art. IV, Pt. 1, § 1(2) & (7).
- The Secretary of State's Office conducted a 5% random sample of eligible petition signatures on July 29, 2016 and selected 11,947 total signatures for verification. A.R.S. §§ 19-121.01(B)-(C).
 - 12 petition sheets containing 15 signatures were transmitted to Apache County.
 - 70 petition sheets containing 81 signatures were transmitted to Cochise County.
 - 285 petition sheets containing 352 signatures were transmitted to Coconino County.
 - 14 petition sheets containing 17 signatures were transmitted to Gila County.
 - 3 petition sheets containing 3 signatures were transmitted to Graham County.
 - 1 petition sheet containing 1 signature was transmitted to Greenlee County.
 - 1 petition sheet containing 1 signature was transmitted to La Paz County.
 - 5,993 petition sheets containing 8,039 signatures were transmitted to Maricopa County.
 - 14 petition sheets containing 16 signatures were transmitted to Mohave County.
 - 31 petition sheets containing 41 signatures were transmitted to Navajo County.
 - 1,949 petition sheets containing 2,672 signatures were transmitted to Pima County.
 - 222 petition sheets containing 284 signatures were transmitted to Pinal County.
 - 56 petition sheets containing 85 signatures were transmitted to Santa Cruz County.
 - 214 petition sheets containing 287 signatures were transmitted to Yavapai County.
 - 40 petition sheets containing 53 signatures were transmitted to Yuma County.
- To qualify for the ballot, the county recorders must validate at least 7,670 signatures (64.2%) from the random sample.
- The deadline for County Recorder review is August 19, 2016. A.R.S. § 19-121.02(A).
