In just a few days, the voter registration deadline of August 1 for the state primary will be upon us. In many cases the primary has a greater impact on the political makeup of the state than the election in November. While general elections typically see substantial turnout (especially in a presidential year) this year's August 30 primary could be easily overlooked.

Early ballots go out two days after the close of registration. Not coincidentally, voters will start receiving robocalls and campaign mailings touting one candidate or tearing down another shortly thereafter.

To help people cut through all of the noise and get to the issues and choices facing them on the August and November ballot, we've developed a website to make it easy to find important information easily. Our website www.Arizona.Vote and www.Arizona.Voto are comprehensive one-stop shops where voters can check the status of their voter registration, find their polling place and learn about candidates or ballot measures.
